Post-doc in human immunology, CIRI-Lyon-France

A post-doctoral position at University of Lyon, France is available to study inflammasome activation and human autoinflammatory diseases. The research project will focus on characterizing inflammasomes dysregulation in various autoinflammatory syndromes. Inflammasome monitoring will be performed in primary human cells from healthy donors and patients with single cell imaging approaches. Mechanistic studies through the use of CRISPR/Cas9 and ectopic expression of various human gene variants will be used. The research project is part of a collaborative European project involving clinicians and fundamental researchers and a large cohort of patients.

This position is opened in the Centre de Recherche en Infectiologie (CIRI, INSERM U1111) in Thomas Henry's team. The CIRI is a highly dynamic environment fostering interactions between immunologists, bacteriologists, virologists and clinicians and providing all the necessary platforms and facilities for the project. This position is opened starting in April 2019 with a one year contract renewable for up to 4 years.

We are looking for a highly motivated applicant with a PhD in immunology and/or expertise in the field of primary human cells, inflammasome and/or innate immunity. Expertise in imaging would be also considered.
